This makes a $11^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished block ( $101 / 2{ }^{1}$ finished). It's a great block for beginners!!

## ** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **

Supplies:
Color 1-1 yd focus fabric
Color $2-3 / 4$ yd Contrast color for $1^{\text {st }}$ block frame (purple fabric)
Color $3-3 / 4$ yd Contrast color for $2^{\text {nd }}$ block frame (green fabric)
Color 4-1 yd of border fabric
Binding - $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$


Start by cutting the Color 1 (focus fabric) into 20-8 inch squares.


Cut Color 2 into 10-2" x 42" (WOF) strips. Cut each strip into $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ " rectangles.


Cut Color 3 into 10-2" x 42" (WOF) strips. Cut each strip into $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and $2-2 " \times 8$ " rectangles.


Next add the shorter ( 8 inch) Color 2 rectangles to the top and bottom of the center unit, again using scant $1 / 4$ " seams. Press seams towards Color 2 strips. Add the longer Color 2 rectangles to the sides, pressing towards the Color 2 strips. This will make 10 blocks. Set seams and square up block to 11 " square.

Repeat this step using Color 3 rectangles to complete the other 10 blocks.

Here are 20 blocks separated by a 1.5 inch
(color 3) sashing.
Finish quilt with Color 4 - 4.5 inch border strips (cut 6).

Finished quilt will measure 50 " x $601 / 2 "$.
